1.) I would like to request a detailed breakdown of the cost to date, along with the payments made and to whom and for what. For the development of changes to the M5 and A46 around Tewkesbury since the idea was originally floated.

2.) As the Council have also agreed an additional spend at the Cabinet meeting on the 15th May 2024 of £3 million, how was this figure calculated and exactly how will it be spent?

- The figure of up to £3M in 2024/2025 was calculated based on the work required for the next stage of the Business Case.
- This will be spent on options identification, preparation for and completion of a non-statutory consultation, transport modelling work and A46 working group Support.
